



Scoring in Darts

SCORING: on a dartboard you can score singles, doubles and triples.

The thin outer ring is worth **double** the number and the thin inner ring is worth **triple** the number. Everything else is worth **single** points.

The only exception is the **inner** and **outer bullseye** in the middle of the board. The outer bull is worth **25 points**, and the inner bull is worth **50 points**.







BULLSEYE (50 POINTS)





OUTER BULLSEYE (25 POINTS)

For Example, If your dart lands in the 11 section you score 11 points.

If it lands in the **outer ring (double)** of the **11 section**, you score **22 points** - because 11 x 2 = 22

If it lands in the inner ring of the 11 section you score 33 points - because $11 \times 3 = 33$
